AEU Apportionment Formula

Apportionments are calculated three ways for each society and billed at the minimum result.

Formula	Societies affected in FY21-22	Percentage of total apportionment in FY21-22
15% of apportionable income	Asheville, Atlanta, Chicago Silicone Valley, Suffolk, Susquehanna Valley	2%
\$30 per member plus 6.5% of apportionable income	All Others	72%
For FY21-22, \$138 per member (CPI-adjusted annually)	Brooklyn, New York, Northern Westchester, Westchester Washington	26%
