

Consulting Leader Program Summary

The AEU's new Consulting Leader Program (CLP) is a targeted grant program for Societies interested in establishing a professional Leader presence in the service of their further growth and development. The CLP is situated in a long tradition of AEU grant funding to its member Societies, including subventions and the Visiting Leader Program. This program is built around a needs assessment conducted by the AEU Leadership Committee amongst multiple societies in 2020. The program will be jointly administered by the AEU's Membership Committee (MC) and Leadership Committee (LC). In the fall the MC and LC will survey societies without professional Leaders and the professional Leader community respectively to identify interested parties. In the months that follow, a match team made up of representatives from both committees will facilitate pairings of Societies and Leaders and shepherd a grant application for consideration by the AEU Board. Funded consultancies are expected to be of one-year's duration with an option to extend. A collaborative process will be put in place to evaluate the effectiveness of the various elements of the program.
